## 12 NSHS Students Selected as 2009 Robert C. Byrd Honors Scholarship Candidates

Byrd Scholarship.



The Robert C. Byrd Honors Scholarship is federally funded and designed for high school graduates or persons with a high school equivalency diploma. The scholarships are allocated by county (a minimum of one per county) with approximately 400 awards available throughout the State for the 2009 competition. Each scholarship carries an award of \$1,500 for the first year of college study and is renewable for up to four years, subject to the availability of Federal Funds.

In order to be eligible to file an application for the 2009 competition, candidates must meet the requirements in the areas of both Grade Point Average (GPA ) and Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) scores (an ACT score will be allowed only if the SAT was not taken). Scholarship winners will be announced later in the year.
