

# Summer Reading

Here are some helpful strategies that readers use when SELECTING a TEXT.

- Read through the various titles and descriptions
- Set aside time to go to the library or to a bookstore with a parent, sibling, or friend in order to enjoy the process of finding your book
- Read the front cover, back cover, first page, and a few pages in the middle and look at the illustrations to see if it interests you
- Check to see how long the book is and ask yourself, "Is this too long to hold my interest or too short to even bother checking it out?"
- Choose another book from a series, from an author, or from a genre that you've enjoyed reading in the past.
- Ask a friend, parent, teacher, or librarian for recommendations
