Dear Parents,

We are very happy to provide everyone with the opportunity to enroll in the Fall 2007 After School Program. We hope that you will be able to find a class that your child will enjoy. Please see the attached list of class offerings and dates.

The program will run for K through 5th grade children beginning Monday, Oct. 29th through Thursday Dec.20th. Each class will meet 6 times; there are no classes scheduled on Oct.31st, Nov.1st, Nov.6th, Nov.12th, and Nov. 21st, 22nd, 23rd. The exact dates of each class are listed on the class schedules. Kindergarten will run from 1:45 and ends promptly at 2:35 p.m., so that the children taking their "stay day" bus may be dismissed along with 1st thru 5th graders. 1st graders thru 5th graders will run from 2:45 to 3:40 p.m. Walkers please see dismissal policy below.

Classes are limited. A minimum of 8 students per class is needed in order for the class to run. **Please indicate a second choice class** in case the first choice is cancelled due to lack of interest or is closed due to a maximum number of students. All classes will be held at The Glen Head Elementary School. Children will report to the cafeteria for class, and their assigned instructors will take them to the designated area where the class will be held.

NEW REGISTRATION POLICY: Student placement is on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE** basis. **One enrollment form per class** must be filled out, sign the behavior policy, and enclose a **separate check for each class** (made payable to the Glen Head School PTO) **No registration forms will be accepted after Friday, Oct. 19th**. Everyone who has completed a registration form will be notified as to the status of his/her enrollment by Thursday, Oct.25th. Be sure to include all information requested on the registration form. Missing information will delay your child's enrollment.

DISMISSAL POLICY: For the safety of your children, **all parents must pick-up their child(ren) at the exterior CAFETERIA DOORS**, which are located down the steps and can be accessed from the walkway (at the rear of the building) that runs from School Street to Prospect Avenue. Dismissal is as follows, Kindergarten walkers at 2:40 p.m. and all 1st thru 5th graders promptly at 3:45 p.m. Please make the necessary arrangements to meet your child at this location only. **CHILDREN ARE NOT PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL AND WALK TO ANY CAR UNACCOMPANIED.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For accounting purposes, **PLEASE MAKE A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH CHILD AND FOR EACH CLASS.** Make checks payable to the **Glen Head School PTO**. Course and material fees are listed with each class selection. **NO** child will be enrolled unless the **TOTAL COURSE FEE** is received at the time of registration.

1. Enrollment fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** under all circumstances unless there is a class cancellation. If a class is cancelled once the program begins, the fee will be refunded proportionately.
2. If your first choice has reached maximum enrollment, your child will automatically be placed in his or her second course choice.
3. Registration forms **WILL NOT** be accepted after Oct.19th.
4. Classes will not be held on Oct.31, Nov.1, Nov.6, Nov.12, Nov.21-23.
5. Tuition scholarships are available for those that are eligible for reduced fee lunch.
6. Parents must submit a written note informing their child's classroom teacher of each class their child is participating in.
7. **DISMISSAL:** For safety reasons, Kindergarten children must be picked up by 2:40 p.m. and 1st -5th grade students must be picked up in the cafeteria by 3:45 p.m. Any child that has not been picked up will be brought to the main office by our attendance coordinator. If your child cannot attend their after school class or is being picked up by someone else, please send in a note labeled **AFTER SCHOOL PTO PROGRAM**. Your child **WILL NOT** be dismissed to anyone else without written permission.

If the inappropriate behavior continues, all teachers have been instructed to notify attendance coordinator, at which time notification will be sent to PTO Executive Board, Co-President Nathalie Woods as well as program coordinator. The student will be given a written notice and a phone call will be made to the parent(s)/guardian(s). The student will be suspended from attending the next class. If behavior still continues, the student will be permanently removed from that after school program. There is a zero tolerance for physical altercations of any kind.
