PROGRAM FOR WINTER 2012

We are pleased to provide our students with an opportunity to enroll in the Winter 2012 After School Clubs and Activities Program. **We are offering some new and exciting classes.** We are confident that you can find at least one class your child will enjoy!!

The **Winter 2012 program will begin the school week of January 16th (though no class will be held on January 16th due to Martin Luther King Jr. holiday) and end in the school week of February 13th.** Attached is a schedule of course dates. The sessions will be 5 weeks long (except for the Monday courses this session) . **Please note the dates they will be held.**

Classes begin at 2:45 pm. and end **promptly** at 3:45 pm (unless otherwise stated) and will meet on the same day of the week for five weeks, consistent with the school calendar. We need a minimum of ten students per class in order for the class to proceed. Please indicate a **second choice**, if you wish, in case the first choice is canceled due to an insufficient amount of participants or is closed out due to a maximum number of students. All classes will be held at the Glenwood Landing School. **It is the parent's responsibility to make arrangements for picking up their child PROMPTLY at 3:45p.m in the classroom.**

REGISTRATION: The registration will be by a lottery system. Please complete the registration forms and place in an envelope marked "SCA SCHOOL AFTER SCHOOL

CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES PROGRAM.” All forms should be placed in the SCA Mailbox in the vestibule of the school main entrance. Please get these forms in ASAP.

We will ONLY notify parents whose child has not been registered in his or her first choice course. If you do not hear from us assume your child has been enrolled in his/her first choice. Enrollment closes January 13th.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1. For accounting purposes, **PLEASE MAKE A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH CHILD AND FOR EACH CLASS. Make checks payable to Glenwood Landing SCA. A check for the TOTAL COURSE FEE should be included with your registration form.**

Course and material fees are listed with each class selection. Please make all checks payable for the **TOTAL COURSE FEE.**

2. Enrollment fees are NON-REFUNDABLE under any circumstances unless there is a class cancellation. If a class is canceled once the program begins, the fee will be refunded proportionately.
3. **The after school committee will notify everyone who has not been registered in their first choice** due to a maximum enrollment in that course or due to a course cancellation. If your first course choice has reached maximum class enrollment, you will be called if you would like to be placed in your second course choice. If you do not have a second choice, you will be placed on a waiting list in the event of an opening in the class.

4. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the child's teacher with a written note the day they are not attending an after school class. We suggest you

send a note in with your child each day he/she is not attending an after school class to remind both your child and the teacher.

5. We have a school monitor to take attendance at the beginning of each class, make any necessary phone calls and monitor the hallways. If your child is not in the class at the time of attendance, a phone call will be made promptly to the numbers listed on the enrollment form. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU PROVIDE A PHONE NUMBER ON THE ENROLLMENT FORM WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED WHILE CLASSES ARE IN SESSION!!**

DISMISSAL: For safety reasons, students must be picked up in the classroom at **3:45 pm**. Teachers will be instructed to bring any children who have not been picked up to the After School Monitor. **Late pick-ups will result in a late charge of \$5.00 per child payable on that day and excessive late pick-ups may cause the child to be dropped from the program.** If a child cannot attend his/her scheduled class, please notify the main office by written note and they will notify the Monitor, so that the Monitor will not be searching for your child while taking attendance. PLEASE be considerate to these instructors who are giving their time and effort for our children. We must have everyone's cooperation in order for this program to be successful!! Thank you.

MAD SCIENCE

Instructor: Mad Science

Grades: K-1-2

Enrollment Max: 20 students

Course Description:

We are fortunate to have Mad Science join us to stimulate and excite our student's minds. Please see the attached flyer for a more extensive description of available topics from which the subject for each session will be drawn. Depending on the composition of the class and the ages of the students enrolled, our students will venture into the realm of insects! They will learn about their unique eyesight, and the way bugs defend themselves against predators. They will discover what the Earth is composed of and how various forces combine to create rocks and minerals, and create a sedimentary stacker to take home. They will try out different types of simple machines: levers, wedges, incline planes, wheels and axles, and pulleys, through various hands-on activities. They will use bouncing balls, yo-yos and other classic toys to discover the science of motion through fun hands-on activities, and find out how vector toys and string things work and bring home a Mad Science Yo-Yo. This is a hands-on course which will engage each child. Each child will get a take home project each week, which he/she can experiment with and share with the family.

Course Description:

We are fortunate to have Mad Science join us to stimulate and excite our student's minds. Please see the attached flyer for a more extensive description of available topics from which the subject for each session will be drawn. Our students will step into the role of a detective and discover how forensic science works to solve crimes. They will create and analyze fingerprints and teeth impressions and discover how written materials can be analyzed to help solve a crime. They will uncover the forces that create earthquakes and discover how mountains are formed. They will step into the shoes of a meteorologist and create regional weather forecasts, and learn about the Sun's energy and ultraviolet radiation and make a U.V. detector to take home. They will sit in a director's chair and discover why science is the real star on the big screen, by exploring the concept of persistence of vision and how we are able to see movies. They will discover how 3-D images are made. And, finally, they will cook up a chemical reaction and blow up a balloon with yeast. This is a hands-on course which will engage each child. Each child will get a take home project each week, which he/she can experiment with and share with the family.
