- Andrea thanked Caryn Quinn for donating the novelty items that were sold during the Fall Plant Sale.

- At this point, a parent asked why the Committee can't give the winning class a pizza party. Noreen said that this year, the school is trying to come up with alternatives to food as rewards for the children. One parent suggested allowing the winning class to play Capture the Flag during teaching time. Another parent suggested a scavenger hunt.
- Mrs. Van Hoff has asked the board to pay \$246 for supplies for the Library Book Club. The \$246 covers the cost of books book club members get to keep.
- Andrea told the membership that the board approved this expense, but that the

membership must vote on it. A motion was made to approve this expenditure. The motion was seconded and approved.

-Liz Falcone has reported to the board that the Fall Catalogue Sale raised \$3000-\$3500. Thanks to everyone who sold the products.

-Deana Roper reported that she is currently waiting for a new order of Spirit Wear. She will place any new orders until the Spring. Mrs. Jacobs said that she would display the Spirit Wear in the gym. A parent asked whether Sea Cliff and Glen Head only have their Holiday Shop on one day. Andrea responded that Glen Head runs theirs on Friday and Saturday and Sea Cliff only runs on Saturday. A parent said that one day is okay for schools that do a lot of other fund raising. The parent was worried that we might not make enough money in just one day. Andrea said that we discussed this issue at the first SCA meeting, and that at that time, Bridget gave her reasons for having the Holiday Shop on a Saturday.

### **Treasurer's Report**

-The audit committee will meet with Linda and Trish tomorrow at Trish's house.

-On November 9<sup>th</sup>, the After School Account and the Main Account were combined. There is an allocation and separate category for the After School money which totals \$8,332.05. A parent said that that from an administrative point of view, if the After School money is not physically separate from the main account, it will be combined with other monies and get lost. Andrea said that the Quicken program that Trish uses does not allow the treasurer to take money from the After School monies.

-As of today, the combined total balance is \$14,204.80. Recent debits include \$850 for the accountant. We still have not paid Jostens. Trish is planning to pay this bill at the end of December. A parent asked for the balances for recreation and the library terrace. Trish will e mail this parent with the information.

-At this time, a parent asked why children are told not to put on their seat belts while they are on the bus during a class trip. -Caryn Quinn reported on the status of the Cultural Arts Committee.
