

N.S.M.S. Ski Trip

Rules and Regulations

- 1) The bus will leave the Middle School at 5:30am sharp. Report by 5:15am to make sure we do not leave without you.
- 2) Bundle your skis and gear in a bag or with straps or tape. Label your equipment with your name, so you can identify it and other people do not grab it.
- 3) Dress appropriately. Wear ski clothes, long underwear, goggles, hats and gloves. Bring a helmet if you own one. Comfort on the mountain will make for an enjoyable day.
- 4) Bring money for lunch and snacks on the mountain and at the rest stops.
- 5) Remember your bus number so you can get on the correct bus on Saturday. There will be no switching busses.
- 6) You may bring your own food and drink to eat on the bus, but you are responsible for cleaning up messes and disposing of all trash before you leave the bus.
- 7) You must bring a watch to keep track of the time. We are scheduled to leave the mountain by 3pm.
- 8) You may bring cards, games, I-pods or books to keep you occupied on the long bus ride. No flash cameras. The flash is distracting and dangerous to the driver.
- 9) You will remain in your seat on the bus and keep your voice down to a conversational tone.
- 10) All students must be with a ski buddy at all times. If you are injured make sure you tell the ski patrol that you are with North Shore Schools and a chaperone will be paged immediately.
- 11) You will lose future trip privileges if you are found on the mountain without a ski partner, if you are involved in disrespectful or dangerous behavior on the bus, or if you do not report back to the bus by 3pm when we are scheduled to leave the mountain.
- 12) Cell phones are encouraged. You may use them to alert your parents as to when we will arrive back at the Middle School.
- 13) We return about 7pm.
