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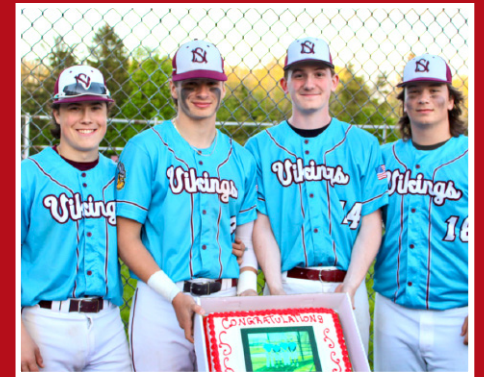

Information for Students and Families



KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Proof of District Residency for Incoming Kindergarteners begins 1/30/23. Registration and Screening will be held at Glenwood Landing School beginning 3/27/23 (thru 3/31/23), at Glen Head School on 3/30/23, 4/4/23, and 4/18/23, and at Sea Cliff School beginning 4/24/23 (thru 4/27/23). A child who is five years old on or before 12/1/23 is eligible for kindergarten for the 2022-23 school year.

SCHOOL CLOSINGS OR DELAYED OPENINGS

School closings or delayed openings are determined by the Superintendent. When schools are closed because of weather conditions, the district requests that announcements be made between 6:30 AM and 8:00 AM over the following radio and TV stations: WHLI (FM-1100), WINS (AM-1010), and Channel 12. The announcement is for "North Shore Central School District, Glen Head, New York." In addition, parents, faculty, and staff will be notified through School Messenger, an emergency notification system that allows the district to contact personnel or parents (by phone and/or email) in a short period of time. A message will also be posted on the North Shore Schools' website at www.northshoreschools.org. Lunch will be served on delayed opening days. When the North Shore Schools are closed, no transportation is provided for any district resident to any school.

SNOW DAYS

The district has three built-in snow days. If a fourth snow day is needed, classes will be held on April 14, 2023.

ASBESTOS COMPLIANCE

The district's regular maintenance of the schools includes asbestos inspection in all facilities. In compliance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), we undertake the following: re-inspect all buildings and spaces every three years for all asbestos-containing building materials, sample previously untested building materials suspected of containing asbestos, update our asbestos management plan. The re-inspection and updated management plans are available for review in the Main Office of each building and at the District Central Office.

USE OF PESTICIDES/CHEMICALS POLICY

It is inappropriate for anyone to bring any cleaning products into the schools. The control of insects and pests within our school buildings and grounds is an ongoing task. Safe-guarding the children and adults who utilize our school buildings is the district's primary objective. On June 15, 2006, the North Shore Board of Education adopted policy #8115 establishing an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Program. The policy restricts the use of insecticide applications and requires that only authorized, trained and licensed individuals dispense pesticides on school property. All pesticide applications will adhere to IPM methods where the least amount of product is used. Written authorization by the Director of School Facilities/Operations is required prior to any action taken. Posting of the affected area and notification to the building occupants is required. Under no circumstances is a district employee, school volunteer or person/organization utilizing district facilities authorized to possess and/or dispense on school grounds or within a school building any type of insecticide/pesticide product. If you have questions or concerns regarding IPM activities, please contact the Facilities Office at 277-7835.

Any student, parent or staff member may register to receive written notification 48 hours prior to a regulated pesticide application. Individuals may request that their name be added to the school registry at any time during the school year. All interested should contact John Hall at 277-7835, Monday-Friday, 8:00 AM-4:00 PM.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation is provided for all kindergarten through twelfth grade students who live over 3/4 of a mile from their schools. Children also are transported to non-public schools within a range of 15 miles, as mandated by state law. Written requests for transportation to non-public schools must be submitted to the coordinator of transportation by April 1 of the preceding school year.

DISTRICT CODE OF CONDUCT

The North Shore Schools Code of Conduct as well as all other Board of Education policies are available on the district website (under Policies & Forms).

ATTENDANCE

The state education law permits legal absence or tardiness for the following reasons only: sickness or death in the family, impassable roads or weather making travel unsafe, religious observance, required presence in court. Parents are requested to advise the school by telephone, early in the morning, of the reason for a child's absence or lateness and to provide the student with a written excuse when he/she returns to school.

HEALTH ISSUES

The school health services help students achieve physical, emotional and social health. School nurses offer individual counseling, instruction and appraisals of health. Policies and procedures established in accordance with NYS requirements govern the care of a student who becomes ill or sustains an injury during the school day. All students must have documented proof of immunity (vaccination, disease, or titers proving immunity - when appropriate.) in accordance with the New York State Department of Health, Public Health Law 2164, to be admitted to school on the first day of the 2022-2023 school year. Immunization requirements for students, in Kindergarten, 6th and 7th grade Middle School students and 12th grade High School students, can be found on the District website under Policies & Forms, Health Forms, Immunization Information. For any questions contact the student's building nurse. The District's Medical Director is available for consultation when required and will perform health examinations when needed as directed by the State Education Department.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Students who are suspected of having a disability may be referred for an evaluation to either the building principal or the Director of Special Education. A determination will be made whether the student's needs can be met by providing services or accommodations within the regular school program. If the student's needs cannot be met with such regular support, and a comprehensive evaluation indicates the need for special education services, an individualized special education program will be developed. A variety of services are available to assist students. For further information, please contact a member of the school's support team (principal, school psychologist, special education teacher, nurse, speech teacher, or social worker) or the Director of Special Education.

SECTION 504

Students with disabilities, but not classified by the committee on Special Education, are entitled to those accommodations deemed necessary to ensure access to all public school programs and activities. Requests for accommodations should be submitted to the Director of Special Education.

Family Educational Rights and North Shore Strategic Plan

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act was enacted as federal law in 1974 to provide parents of a student under 18 and parents of a dependent student 18 years of age or older, with the right to inspect and review any and all records, files, and data directly related to the student. The district has the option under FERPA of designating certain categories of student information as “directory information”. The Board directs that “directory information” including a student’s name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, major course of study, participation in officially recognized school activities or sports, weight and height if a member of an athletic team, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, and most recent school attended. Once the proper FERPA notification is given by the district, a parent/guardian or eligible student will have 14 days to notify the district of any objections they have to any of the “directory information” designations. If not objection is received, the district may release this information without prior approval of the parent/guardian or eligible student for the release. The district may elect to provide a single notice regarding both directory information and information disclosed to military recruiters.

Parents who do not wish this type of information/photos about their child to be released should forward a letter to Shelly Newman, Director of Public Relations/ Senior Illustrator, North Shore Schools, 112 Franklin Avenue, Sea Cliff, NY 11579 by September 28, 2022.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

The Board of Education, its officers and its employees, shall not discriminate against any student, employee or applicant on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, religion, marital status, sex, age, veteran status, sexual orientation, or disability.

TITLE IX

The North Shore Central School District does not discriminate on the basis of sex in the educational programs or activities which it operates, and is required by Title IX of the Educational Amendments of 1972 not to discriminate in such a manner. BOARD POLICY 5450.1-R

Notification of Sex Offenders Regulation: If the Superintendent of Schools receives a notification to the school district from the local law enforcement agency, the North Shore Schools will inform personnel and residents as necessary to fulfill their responsibility to protect children while in school care. Specifically, a picture of the individual shall be provided to: (1) Building principals, who shall advise staff who regularly greet visitors; (2) Bus drivers; (3) The head custodian of each building, who shall advise custodians on duty when children are in the building; (4) Security personnel; and (5) Coaches. The Superintendent or a designee shall send a list of all groups that regularly use school facilities when children are in attendance (daycare providers, e.g.) to the local law enforcement agency with a request that the agency notify the groups. If the agency refuses to provide information to these groups, the schools shall forward a picture of the individual to the leader(s) of such group. Any further inquiries shall be referred to the local law enforcement agency. (Adoption date: June 15, 2006).
