We are having a stellar year where our students have excelled in academics, the arts, and athletics. Bravo to the talented MS Masquers' cast and crew of "Cinderella". It was a magical performance with singing and dancing!




#### EIGHTH GRADERS PARTICIPATE IN HISTORY DAY AT MS
