F. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION TO SET THE DATE OF THE ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District has determined that the date, time and place of the Annual School District Budget Vote and Election (Annual Meeting) will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. at the Gymnasium of the North Shore Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a proposition adopted by the qualified voters of this District, this Board has heretofore determined that vacancies upon the Board of Education shall not be considered separate specific offices, and that those candidates receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected to the vacancies upon the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the qualified voters shall elect two (2) members to the Board of Education for three (3) year terms each, commencing on July 1, 2017, and expiring on June 30, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has adopted the registration requirements for eligibility to vote contained in Section 2014 of the Education Law and such registration requirements have not been changed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has previously adopted by resolution the absentee ballot provisions and procedures contained in Section 2018-a of the Education Law for school district elections and said resolution has not been changed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the vote be taken by voting machine, or, if voting machines be unavailable, by paper ballot; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Proposition on the 2017-2018 School Budget shall read as follows:

RESOLVED, that the School District budget for the school year 2017-2018 proposed by the Board of Education in accordance with Section 1716 of the Education Law shall be approved and the necessary taxes be levied therefore on the taxable real property of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a proposition regarding school transportation eligibility shall read as follows:

RESOLVED: that the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District is hereby authorized to modify its public school transportation eligibility effective at the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year for Grades 7 and 8 pupils only from the existing one and one-half (1.5) mile limit to a new one (1) mile limit at no additional cost to the District

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School District Budget for the 2017-2018 school year will be completed and presented at a public hearing to be held on May 4, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. and will be available for inspection at each of the schoolhouses of the District during business hours during the 14 days preceding the election, together with the text of any resolution which will be presented to the voters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Registration will meet to register qualified voters on the following dates, time and place:

Saturday, May 6, 2017, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Registration will be held at the North Shore Schools Administrative Offices, 112 Franklin Avenue, Sea Cliff, New York; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to publish such notice of said Annual Budget Vote and Election in the Glen Cove Record Pilot and Sea Cliff/Glen Head Herald Gazette as shall be required by law, which said notice shall be substantially in the form hereto annexed as ADDENDUM "A," which said Addendum is deemed to be part of this Resolution; and
