RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A NEW CAPITAL RESERVE FUND WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District ("Board") has determined that there is a need to create a capital reserve fund to cover, in whole or in part, the cost of future capital improvements, renovations and/or alterations of School District facilities and property; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that a proposition be presented to the voters of the School District authorizing the establishment of a capital reserve fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the North Shore Central School District at the Annual District Meeting to be held between the hours of 7:00 am and 10:00 pm on May 18, 2021 at the polling place heretofore established within the District; and that the District Clerk be hereby authorized and directed to give notice of such proposition to be voted at said Annual District Meeting by publishing a notice thereof, four times within the seven (7) weeks next preceding the Annual District Meeting, the first publication to be at least forty-five (45) days before the election, and to have the necessary ballot labels printed for said vote in the form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law and the provisions of the voting machine rules of this school district:

Proposition No. 2 – Establishment of a Capital Reserve Fund RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District ("Board"), is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund, known as the "2021 Capital Reserve Fund," in accordance with the provisions of Education Law section 3651, for the purpose of financing district wide building and capital improvements, property acquisition, renovations and/or alterations, including but not limited to construction and/or replacement of district facilities, athletic fields, field lighting, turf fields, tracks, wellness centers, equipment, gym floors, storage, bathrooms, wooded trails, fencing, dugouts, bleachers, structures, site work, and property, capital improvements related to future enrollment growth needs, other infrastructure improvements, district wide purchases, improvements and/or replacement of technology and telecommunications equipment, and similar projects and associated expenses. This capital reserve fund shall be for a probable term of ten (10) years, expiring on June 30, 2031, and shall be capitalized in a total amount not to exceed Eight Million Two Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand dollars (\$8,275,000), plus accrued interest, during the term of the fund. The source of funding of the capital reserve fund will be an annual transfer of surplus monies, if any, from the District's General Fund's unassigned fund balance as may be available and designated by the Board as of the end of each fiscal year from June 30, 2021 through and including June 30, 2031, and any other sources permitted by law.

F. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION FOR THE DATE OF THE ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the North Shore Central School District has determined that the date, time and place of the Annual School District Budget Vote and Election (Annual Meeting) will be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. at the Gymnasium of the North Shore Senior High School; and WHEREAS, pursuant to a proposition adopted by the qualified voters of this District, this Board has heretofore determined that vacancies upon the Board of Education shall not be considered separate specific offices, and that those candidates receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected to the vacancies upon the Board of Education; and WHEREAS, the qualified voters shall elect two (2) members to the Board of Education for three (3) year terms each, commencing on July 1, 2021, and expiring on June 30, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has adopted the registration requirements for eligibility to vote contained in Section 2014 of the Education Law and such registration requirements have not been changed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has previously adopted by resolution the absentee ballot provisions and procedures contained in Section 2018-a of the Education Law for school district elections and said resolution has not been changed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the vote be taken by voting machine, or, if voting machines be unavailable, by paper ballot; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Proposition on the 2021-2022 School Budget shall read as follows:

RESOLVED, that the School District budget for the school year 2021-2022 proposed by the Board of Education in accordance with Section 1716 of the Education Law shall be approved and the necessary taxes be levied therefore on the taxable real property of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School District Budget for the 2021-2022 school year will be completed and presented at a public hearing to be held on May 6, 2021 at 7:45 p.m. and will be available for inspection at each of the schoolhouses of the District during business hours during the 14 days preceding the election, together with the text of any resolution which will be presented to the voters. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Registration will meet to register qualified voters on the following date, time and place: Tuesday, April 20, between the hours of 9:00 am and 1:00 p.m. and Saturday, May 8, 2021, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Registration will be held at the North Shore Schools Administrative Offices, 112 Franklin Avenue, Sea Cliff, New York; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to publish such notice of said Annual Budget Vote and Election in the Glen Cove Record Pilot and Sea Cliff/Glen Head Herald Gazette as shall be required by law, which said notice shall be substantially in the form hereto annexed as ADDENDUM "A," which said Addendum is deemed to be part of this Resolution; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following persons be appointed to serve as Election Inspectors and/or Poll Workers of the Annual Election:
