"Tax levy increases, in any school district, are not the same as personal property tax increases."

- ✓ Annual tax changes for an individual home are affected by (l) Changes in a homeowner's assessed value, and (2) An overall shift to property tax class l (residential homeowners). Both are determined by Nassau County. It is NOT ACCURATE that an overall change in a school district's tax levy will equal the same tax change for every home in that district.
- √ When the GWL LIPA Plant was taken off the tax rolls this year, Nassau County increased the percentage of the total school tax levy paid by individual homeowners (Class 1) to over 83%. This continues the following annual increase trend to homeowners: 74% in 2022, 65% in 2009, and only 54% in 2001.
