# LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION

The North Shore School District is a unique educational community with a population of approximately 17,000. The district is located in a suburban area on the North Shore of Long Island known as the Gold Coast, approximately 30 miles from New York City. It is comprised of five public schools that serve a rich mix of students, whose academic performance is consistently high. Our district includes Glen Head Elementary School, Glenwood Landing Elementary School, Sea Cliff School, North Shore Middle School, and North Shore High School.
